I am writing you in regard to a farm to market road we are very much interested in.

We would like to have your approval of Farm to Market Road between here and El Dorado Springs finished as soon as possible. It has been rumored here that we would not get this road finished.

Col. Claud C. Earp called a meeting in El Dorado Springs a few weeks ago and we had a good delegation from Jerico Springs and along the route and also from El Dorado Springs and had a very harmonous meeting.

I just want to make this statement some time last fall there were a vacancy here created when J. W. Farmer had to resign on the account of his Job as Foreman on the WPA who is a Pendergast man, I circulated a petition signed by our best class of democrats asking you to appoint Harry H. Swisher which you did for Committeeman and this is why you received all of the delegates from here. We sent 7 delegates from Cedar Co. for you at the St. Louie Convention. I am doing all in my power to put you over. Col. Earp can tell you how I stand for you.

If you have any place where I can do more for you I will only be to glad to do so.
