740	ATTENTION ALL CARS ESPECIALLY OUTSIDE PEACE OFFICERS IN COUNTIES SOUTH OF -KANSAS CITY—There have been 7 persons either killed or fatally injured in front of the Union station in shooting scrape when Federal Officer was returning prisoners through Union Station. 2 men identified as officers of K. C. Police Dept. 1 killed & 1 fatally injured. The 2 men who did the shooting wearing blue shirts escaped in Chev. sed. 33 Mo.Lic # 428-329, black color, these men are armed with machine guns, escaped towards Penn Valley Park. Use all caution in the apprehension of these men.	
820	PICKUP ON SHOOTING 2 white men wearing blue shirts, Mo.Lic. # 428-329 or Mo. Lic. 482-239, black Chev. sed. armed with machine guns. Escaped going south to Penn Valley Park, probably headed for Kansas.	
824	ATTENTION ALL CARS Be on lookout for 2 white men, drk shirts in small drk cpe. Just seen going south through Mission Hills District on Hiway # 50, headed west, driving very fast, appeared very nervous.
