COMMITMENT

The President of the United States of America—  
To the Marshal of the United States for the WESTERN District of Missouri and to the  
Superintendent of the United States Industrial Reformatory at Chillicothe, Ohio, GREETING:

Whereas, at the November term of said Court, 1933, held at KANSAS CITY in said district and division, to wit, on December 19, 1933, Joe Giarameta was sentenced by said Court, upon his plea of guilty to be committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the United States or his authorized representative, for imprisonment in a (Correctional Institution) for and during the term and period of One (1) year and one (1) day (without costs) beginning on the date on which he is received at the (Correctional Institution) for service of said sentence; or if said prisoner shall be committed to a jail or other place of detention to await transportation to the place at which his sentence is to be served, said sentence shall begin on the date on which he is received at such jail or other place of detention; and to pay a fine to the United States in the sum of \$100.00 and to stand committed until such fine shall be paid, or until he shall be otherwise discharged by due course of law, for violation of Sec. 281, 193, 307 & 291 Title 26 USCA (possession of unregistered still)

And Whereas, the Attorney General of the United States has designated the United States Industrial Reformatory at Chillicothe, Ohio, as the place of confinement where the sentence of said Joe Giarameta shall be served;

Now, this is to command you, the said Marshal, forthwith to take said Joe Giarameta and him safely transport to said United States Industrial Reformatory and him there deliver to said Superintendent of said United States Industrial Reformatory with a copy of this writ; and you, the said Superintendent, to receive said Joe Giarameta and him keep and imprison in accordance with said sentence, or until he shall be otherwise discharged by due course of law.
