Present **Richard Phelps**, District Attorney, also the accused, in proper person, having **Herman C. Moore** for his counsel.

There were sworn as witnesses for the United States **J. B. Keenan, G. A. Palmer, W. D. McCrabb**

I held the defendant as probably guilty, and required of **them** a recognizance in the sum of **\$1500.00** with surety in same amount, to appear in the **District** Court of the United States for the said District, at **Kansas City** on the **2** day of **Mar**, **1936**, which recognizance was executed by said defendant with **Cesari Neingroni & Joe Patito** sureties.
