ORDER

It appearing to the Court that the defendant, Buster Balestrere, was placed on probation in this court for a period of five years on July 29, 1936, upon his plea of guilty to an indictment charging violation of the Internal Revenue Act, to-wit, possession of a fifty gallon whiskey still.
