The President of the United States of America—
To the Marshal of the United States for the WESTERN District of MISSOURI and to the Warden
of the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth , Kansas, GREETING:

Whereas, at the November term of said Court, 1936, held at KANSAS CITY in said district and division, to wit, on February 25th, 1937, Edson M. Walker was sentenced by said Court, upon his conviction by a jury to be committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the United States or his authorized representative, for imprisonment in a (Penitentiary) for and during the term and period of Two (2) years beginning on the date on which he is received at the (Penitentiary) for service of said sentence; or if said prisoner shall be committed to a jail or other place of detention to await transportation to the place at which his sentence is to be served, said sentence shall begin on the date on which he is received at such jail or other place of detention; to stand committed until he shall be otherwise discharged by due course of law, for violation of Section 51, Title 18, U.S.C.A.

And Whereas, the Attorney General of the United States has designated the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas at the place of confinement where the sentence of said Edson M. Walker shall be served;

Now, this is to command you, the said Marshal, forthwith to take said Edson M. Walker And safely transport to said United States Penitentiary and him there deliver to said Warden of said Penitentiary with a copy of this writ; and you, the said Warden, to receive said Edson M. Walker and him keep and imprison in accordance with said sentence, or until he shall be otherwise discharged by due course of law,

upon his conviction by a jury to be committed to the custody of the Attorney General of the
United States or his authorized representative, for imprisonment in a (Penitentiary) for and
during the term and period of Two (2) years, beginning on the date on which he is received at
the (Penitentiary) for service of said sentence; or if said prisoner shall be committed to a jail or
