JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE

This 2nd day of June, 1937, comes Maurice M. Milligan, United States Attorney, also come the defendants, George Arnold, Gene Riley, Irene Irvin, Robert Strohm and Thomas Audley, in their own proper persons and with counsel; thereupon the Motion for New Trial and in Arrest of Judgment heretofore filed by the defendants Gene Riley, Irene Irvin, Robert Strohm and Thomas Audley is taken up, submitted and by the Court overruled; thereupon it appearing to the Court that the defendant George Arnold has heretofore entered a plea of guilty, and that the defendants Gene Riley, Irene Irvin, Robert Strohm and Thomas Audley have heretofore been tried by a Jury and found guilty as charged in counts one and two of the indictment herein, and that said cause has been regularly continued to this date for sentence, and the United States Attorney having moved for sentence said defendants were called upon to state reasons, if any they have, why sentence should not now be pronounced upon them, and none being stated, and the Court being fully advised in the premises it is ordered that the punishment of the said defendant, George Arnold, be fixed at imprisonment in the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, for a period of two (2) years on each of counts one and two of the indictment; the imprisonment imposed on count two to run concurrently with the sentence of imprisonment imposed on count one, and further that he

pay a fine in the sum of One Hundred Dollars on each of said counts one and two, said fines to be collected upon execution, without costs; the execution of said sentence of imprisonment in suspended and said defendant is placed upon probation for a period of two (2) years; that the punishment of the said defendant, Gene Riley, be fixed at imprisonment in the United States Southwestern Reformatory at El Reno, Oklahoma, for a period of two (2) years on each of counts one and two of the indictment; the imprisonment imposed on count two to run concurrently with the sentence of imprisonment imposed on count one, and further that he pay a fine in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars on each of said counts one and two, said fines to be collected upon execution, without costs; that the punishment of the said defendant, Irene Irvin, be fixed at imprisonment in the Clay County jail at Liberty, Missouri, for a period of sixty (60) days on each of counts one and two of the indictment; the imprisonment imposed on count two to run concurrently with the sentence of imprisonment imposed on count one, and further that she pay a fine in the sum of One Hundred Dollars on each of said counts one and two, said fines to be collected upon execution, without costs; that the punishment of the said defendant, Robert Strohm, be fixed at imprisonment in the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, for a period of five (5) years on each of counts one and two of the indictment; the

imprisonment imposed on count two to run concurrently with the sentence of imprisonment imposed on count one, and further that he pay a fine in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars on each of said counts one and two, said fines to be collected upon execution, without costs, and that the punishment of the said defendant, Thomas Audley, be fixed at imprisonment in the United States Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, for a period of three (3) years on each of counts one and two of the indictment; the imprisonment imposed on count two to run concurrently with the sentence of imprisonment imposed on count one, and further that he pay a fine in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars on each of said counts one and two, said fines to be collected upon execution, without costs.

Thereupon the defendants Gene Riley, Irene Irvin, Robert Strohm and Thomas Audley file their separate Notices of Appeal which are allowed by the Court and ordered filed and made a part of the record herein. Bail bonds on behalf of said defendants are fixed as follows: Gene Riley \$4,000.00; Irene Irvin \$1,000.00; Robert Strohm \$10,000.00, and Thomas Audley \$5,000.00; costs bonds are fixed in the sum of \$250.00 as to each defendant.

Come now the said defendants Riley, Irvin, Strohm and Audley and present their ball bonds and cost bonds signed by themselves as principals and by the Central Surety and Insurance Corporation as surety which are approved by the Court and ordered filed.
