The Grand Jurors of the United States of America, duly and legally chosen, selected, summoned and drawn from the body of the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, and duly and legally examined, empaneled, sworn and charged to inquire of and concerning crimes and offenses against the United States of America in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, on their oaths present and charge that on or about the 22nd day of May, 1920, at Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Division and District aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this court, one Paul Di Giovanni, then and there being, did then and there unlawfully and wilfully sell, for beverage purposes, to one Henry C. Thompson, a certain quantity of intoxicating liquor, to-wit, one quart of wine, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.

Second Count.

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, on their oaths aforesaid, do further present and charge that on or about the 26th day of May, 1920, at Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Division and District aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this court, one Paul Di Giovanni, then and there being, did then and there unlawfully and wilfully possess a certain quantity of intoxicating liquor, to-wit, two quarts of wine, two quarts of gin, and four quarts of whiskey, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
