Robert R. Brewster, Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, who prosecutes for and on behalf of the United States, comes now in person and on his official oath and upon the affidavit of one Walter E. Payne, Federal Prohibition Agent, which is hereto attached and marked "Exhibit A", informs the Court and gives the Court to understand that on or about the 30th day of May, 1927, at 1214 Woodland Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, one Frank DeLuca, then and there being, did then and there unlawfully and wilfully, and in violation of the National Prohibition Act, possess for beverage purposes, a certain quantity of intoxicating liquor, to-wit: seventyone (71) pints and seventeen gallons (17) of whisky and one (1) gallon of alcohol, contrary to the form of the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
