The Grand Jurors of the United States of America, duly and legally empaneled, examined, sworn and charged to inquire of and concerning crimes and offenses against the United States of America, in the Western District of Missouri, upon their oaths present and charge that on the 12th day of March, 1926, and continuously thereafter, SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and PRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO, whose true names other than as herein set forth are to these Grand Jurors unknown, within the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, at Kansas City, Missouri, and at other places to these Grand Jurors unknown, did unlawfully, wilfully and feloniously conspire, confederate and agree together among themselves and with each other to commit offenses against the laws of the United States and more particularly Title 2 of the National Prohibition Act, in this, that the said SOLLY WEISSMAN,

BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and PRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO would sell, barter, transport, deliver, furnish and possess intoxicating liquor in violation of the National Prohibition Act.

And the Grand Jurors, aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present and charge that pursuant to said unlawful conspiracy, combination, confederation and agreement, and to effect the object and purpose of the same, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, PRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and PRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did commit certain overt acts, which said overt acts are specifically as follows:

1. That on the 7th day of March, 1926, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and PRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully transport for beverage purposes from Buffalo, New York, to and into Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, ninety-four- (94) drums of alcohol.
2. That on the 12th day of March, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELENE. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully possess for beverage purposes ninety-four (94) drums of alcohol.
3. That on the 12th day of March, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City,

Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY

WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN S. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully sell and deliver for beverage purposes ninety- four (94) drums of alcohol.

4. That on the 20th day of April, 1926, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN S. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully transport for beverage purposes from Long Dock, New Jersey, to and into Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

5. That on the 22nd day of April, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and PRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully possess for Leverage purposes one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

6. That on the 22nd day of April, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and "FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully and wilfully sell and deliver for Leverage purposes, one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

7. That on the 4th day of May, 1926, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO

did unlawfully transport for beverage purposes from Long Look, New Jersey, to and into Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

8. That on the 10th day of May, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully possess for beverage purposes one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

9. That on the 10th day of May, 1926, at 2932 Fairmount Avenue, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in the Western Division of the Western District of Missouri, the said SOLLY WEISSMAN, BOB RIPPEN, FRANK (FRED) MALLOY, JOSEPH L. TINGLE, EMMA AMSLER alias HELEN E. JOHNSON, and FRANK "CHEE CHEE" DEMAYO did unlawfully sell and deliver for beverage purposes one hundred and six (106) drums of alcohol.

And the Grand Jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do say that all of the overt acts alleged to have been committed, were committed in the furtherance of said conspiracy and to effect the object and purpose of the same; Contrary to the form of the statute in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
