The undersigned, party of the first part and second part, respectively, agree as follows:

The party of the second part hereby agrees to furnish Harlan Leonard's K. C. Rockets (6) Musicians, members of

AS THEIR AGENT, to party of the first part, for \$42.00

for Three hours 10:p.m. to 1:a.m.

Co-Eds Club, June 6th 1938, Little Theatre

service to consist of playing dance music with an intermission of 15 minutes.

Settlement to be made on or before 12:p.m. June 6th, 1938

Overtime \$1.00 per man per half-hour.

As the Musicians engaged under the stipulations of this contract are members of the American Federation of Musicians, nothing in this contract shall ever be so construed as to interfere with any obligation which the Musicians owe to the American Federation of Musicians by reason of their prior obligation to the American Federation of Musicians as members thereof.

As the Musicians engaged under the provisions of this contract are members of the American Federation of Musicians, the employer represents that there exists no claim of any kind or nature against said employer in favor of any member of said Federation, and that no member of said Federation will be required to perform any provision of this agreement or render any services for said employer so long as there may remain

unsatisfied or unpaid, in whole or in part, any claim against said employer by, or on behalf of any member of the Federation.

The party of the second part agrees to fulfill provisions of above.
