I hereby consent and agree;

That my admission to the Home is not by reason of any right, or consideration of any payment on my part, but because its proper authorities, so far as they know me and are acquainted with my disposition, habits and character, think me worthy of its care;

That by such admission I acquire no rights not subject to their discretion, judgment and determination;

That I will be at all times, subject to, and will obey each and every rule and regulation they have made or shall make, adopt or recognize for its management and the conduct of its residents;

That I will cheerfully and without question at all times render such aid and assistance in the necessary work of the Home, as the Superintendent or her authorized assistant shall require of me;

That my remaining in the Home is to be at all times a matter within the discretion and wholly within the control of the Board of Managers, and if at any time or for any good and sufficient reason a majority of the Board of Managers shall think it expedient for the good of the Home, they shall have the right to remove or cause me to be removed from it;

Provided, however, that if I shall be so removed within one year after my admission the honorarium or sum paid on my admission shall Be returned to me or to the party giving it, less eight dollars (\$8) per week for each week I have been a resident of the Home;

And, if it shall hereinafter appear that the statements I made to the authorities of the Home as to my being poor and dependent and not having any property is inaccurate, or if after I have been received into the Home as a resident, I shall acquire any property which I do not convey over to the Home, in that case, I hereby agree to pay to the Home as board and for the care exercised over me Eight Dollars (\$8) per week for each week of the entire time I have resided in the Home, or from the time I may have come into possession of such property as the case may be.

I hereby agree to all the terms of the foregoing agreement.
