NEUROPSYCHIATRIC:      Superior intelligence. Excellent personality. No evidence of nervous or mental disease. This man has shown a very favorable attitude here. Works in the office of the Educational Director. His attitude regarding the political situation, in which he became enmeshed and which sent him here is hard to ascertain. He certainly wishes wholeheartedly that he had never become involved in politics, and seems also to feel rather deeply about the wrong that was committed under a corrupt city administration. He plans to stay out of politics, as he has to anyway, for he has five years probation, and to give his entire attention to some country newspapers which he maintains, and which he believe will adequately support him.

1 (b) MEDICAL: Fair general health. Somewhat overweight. He has an enlarged heart and a widening of the ascending aorta, probably the result of syphilis, although he has no active syphilis at the present time.
