Not previously questioned by Committee. Penna was chauffeur and bodyguard for Charles Binaggio. Penna is believed to have the true story of the Binaggio murder. On the day of the killing Binaggio unaccountably left Penna waiting at the Last Chance Saloon where he remained until four o'clock that morning. After the murder and before the police could apprehend Penna, Tony Gizzo apprehended him & brought him to the Coates House where he questioned him for several hours as he did with other hoodlums, presumably arranging a coherent story. Penna was also on the payroll of the Duke Sales Company which is owned by Max Ducov, Tony, Gizzo, Binnaggio and distributes the Canadian Ace Beer.
