Have checked the records on dockets in the above captioned case relative to Marshal's costs and expenses and find that we have received in year of 1939, \$5.10 and in the year of 1940, \$5.98, making a total of \$11.08 received by US Marshal from J. H. Polson, It may be possible that Brother Polson has advanced some of these amounts to the Marshal when he made his report and has never been reimbursed yet, suggest that you ask Polson first, So far as our records show, the books balance.
