(1) all correspondence between Lucile Bluford and any officer of Lincoln university beginning 1939 to date regarding graduate work in journalism

(2) all correspondence with and memoranda submitted by any officer of the University of Missouri regarding possible inauguration of courses in journalism at Lincoln University, beginning 1939 to date

(3) All correspondence, faculty minutes and memoranda showing steps taken with dates thereof culminating in the inauguration of a department of Journalism at Lincoln University in February, 1942

(4) all correspondence, faculty minutes and memoranda showing steps taken with dates thereof culminating in the inauguration of the Lincoln University Law School at St. Louis, September, 1939.

(5) all minutes of the board of curators, or the executive committee of the board of curators, Lincoln University beginning 1935 relating to inauguration of law courses or journalism courses at Lincoln University.

(6) all personnel records showing educational training and professional experience of present teachers of journalism, Lincoln University.

(7) all descriptive catalogues showing journalism courses offered or scheduled at Lincoln University as of February, 1942.
