Dear Mr. Teasdale:

Enclosed herewith you will find Subpoena Duces Tecum, one copy for return and one copy for service, as requested by you.

The fee of a witness is \$1.50 per day, for the first day; the mileage fee is 5 cents per mile for the round trip. I am not certain as to the number from St. Louis and return, as we base our fees on mileage within the Western District only. But you can ascertain the number of miles from St. Louis to Jefferson City and return, at 5 cents per mile, and add the witness fee of \$1.50 thereto, and that will be the amount required to be tendered to your witness. Only the amount for mileage within this district, however, could be recovered.

There is no expense incurred for the issuance of the subpoena, if not served by the Marshal.
