Dear President Middlebush:

As I understand the fact to be Miss Bluford wrote a letter to the Registrar in regard to an application for enrollment and her letter was answered by the Registrar. As far as I am advised this matter was never referred to the Board of Curators and no action has ever been taken by the Board of Curators.

On that assumption we recommend that you write to Mr. Redmond substantially as follows:

"In reply to your inquiry of October 3 I beg to advise that no application of Miss Lucille Bluford has ever come before the Board of Curators of the University of Missouri, and there are no minutes of the board pertaining to the subject. Under existing laws of this state Miss Bluford should apply to the Curators of Lincoln University."
