ORDER

The Court is informed that there is now in the possession of the Bureau of Prohibition at Kansas City, Missouri, a quantity of grain alcohol which has been lawfully seized and confiscated from Guy Brock. That the Children's Mercy Hospital at Kansas City, Missouri, has requested the Prohibition Bureau for Fifty gallons of grain alcohol to be used for medicinal purposes.

WHEREFORE it is ordered that George P. Small, Deputy Administrator Bureau of Prohibition, who has the custody of the aforesaid alcohol, release to the Children's Mercy Hospital Fifty (50) gallons of the aforesaid grain alcohol to be used as aforesaid.
