MOTION FOR BILL OF PARTICULARS

Defendant ROBERT EMMET O'MALLEY moves the Court to require plaintiff to file a bill of particulars in the following respects, to-wit:

(1) As to Count One of the indictment by specifying when, where, from whom, in what form and for what consideration defendant is alleged to have received Twenty- Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00), described in the first Count of the indictment as "Income received in connection with compromise and settlement of the Missouri Fire Insurance and Rate Litigation."

(2) As to Count Two of the indictment by specifying when, where, from whom, in what form and for what consideration defendant is alleged to have received Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00), described in the second Count of the indictment as "Income received in connection with compromise and settlement of the Missouri Fire Insurance and Rate Litigation."

Defendant states that he cannot properly and adequately prepare his defense and cannot and does not know what facts and witnesses to be prepared to present at the trial unless and until plaintiff specifies what it alleges and claims the facts

WHEREFORE, defendant prays a bill of particulars in the respects mentioned.
