McCORMACK, on or about the 17th day of July, 1940, at St. Louis, Missouri, in the Eastern District of Missouri, is a fugitive from justice, in that he is charged in an indictment returned by the United States District Court for the Western District of Missouri, at Kansas City, Missouri, on the 13th day of July, A. D. 1940, with violation of Title 18, Section 88, United States Code, a copy of which indictment is attached hereto and made a part hereof;

Affiant, therefore, prays that removal proceedings be instituted against said defendant to compel his appearance forthwith before the United States District Court for the Western District of Missouri, at Kansas City, Missouri, then and there to answer to the charge mad against him in said indictment; contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
