OMAR ROSE, of lawful age, being duly sworn, makes oath and says:

My name is Omar Rose; I am and have been a resident of Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, for seven years. I am married and reside at 213 East 34th Street Terrace, Kansas City, Missouri. I am at present and have for the past seven years been employed by Stern, Slegman & Prins as a cutter.

I am a member and president of Local 250 of the International Ladies Garment Workers Union of North Kansas City, Missouri, and have been since the organization of said Local in February, 1937. The membership of Local 250 is approximately two hundred and twenty.

Prior to the execution of the contract between my employer and the union in February, 1937, the cutters were paid a flat weekly wage. We received no additional pay if we were required to work overtime or on Saturdays. Since the union contract we have received over time at the rate of \$1.17 an hour for every hour we work over thirty five hours per week. This increase has made me nearly \$250.00 additional wage so far this year.

I know that the hours of the operators have been reduced since February, 1937, and the piece work price increased. A splendid spirit of cooperation prevails in our factory and the executives of the company have cooperated fully with our various shop committees and the employes are more contented and have a feeling of economic security which did not exist prior to February, 1937. My contact with the officers of our company makes believe that the employer is much better satisfied with present conditions than with the conditions existing before the unionization of the factory.

Local 250 has its regular monthly meetings at the office of the Kansas City Joint Board in Kansas City, Missouri, and our members participate in the various activities fostered and sponsored by the Kansas City Joint Board.
