White, 33; Wells Revised Alpha, Form 5; surpasses 99 per cent of the inmate population. Binet Equiv. M.A. 19:3, I. Q. 120 - a superior performance. Surpasses only 36 per cent in his voluntary motor output - tapping test - a fair performance; surpasses 86 per cent in accuracy on the manipulative dexterity test - Ferguson Form Board, No. 3 - an excellent performance. Commendable clinical output with the exception of low average voluntary motor output. (Percentiles based on inmate standardization.)

Neurological examination is negative.

This is a tall, well developed, well nourished, white man of athletic habitus, who says that he is in good health. Asserts this to be his first conflict with the law and the records do not show anything to the contrary. He has been committed to this institution for violating the Voting Laws in the Kansas City Election Scandal of 1936. He gives as his occupation: Bill Clerk for the Kansas City Water Co., Street Inspection and general labor.

This man claims to have optic atrophy of the right eye. He reports twelve years of

school training stating that he graduated from high school at the age of nineteen. He is intelligent and exhibits considerable native ability and culture. He is friendly, alert, cooperative and agreeable. His attitude toward the law or the institution appears to be good and it is believed he will profit from his experience in this instance and make a good adjustment. There are no psychotic findings.
