4. b. NEUROPSYCHIATRIC REPORT

White, 37; Wells Revised Alpha, Form 5; surpasses 90 per cent of the inmate population. Binet Equiv. M.A. 17:6, I.Q. 109 - an excellent performance. Surpasses only 18 per cent in his voluntary motor output - tapping test - a poor performance; surpasses 57 per cent in accuracy on the manipulative dexterity test - Ferguson Form Board, No. 3 - a good performance. With the exception of low voluntary motor output the remainder of his clininal performance is commendable. (Percentiles based on inmate standardization.)

Neurological examination is essentially negative.

This man claims to have spotted amnesia. Says that at times he can remember well and at others he can not. He is of the asthenic, pyknic type and is fairly well developed but apparently under nourished. Asserts that he has had no previous conflict with the law in any form and tha records do not show otherwise. He was committed to this institution for a period of two years for his part in the 1936 Kansas City Election Fraud. Says that his work has been pipe laying.

Says that he attended school for nine years. States that his father died when he was six years old and this influence on his early life has apparently curtailed his educational advantages. He thinks there is something pshsically wrong with him. Says that at times he drags his legs and can not use his hands. His symptoms does not coincide with his claims. He is of a hysterical nature. He is pleasant and cooperative and does not appear to be vicious. We anticipate no custodial problems. There are no psychotic findings.

CLASSIFICATION: Excellent test intelligence; emotionally unstable with hysterics; socially inadequate.

CUSTODY: Minimum.

SCHOOLING: Recommended, because he has an E.A. of only 14:6.
