4. (a). Medical treatment for Diabetes. Dental treatment. Should be refracted for glasses.

5. (a). Mechanical Service -Machine Shop: Light duty recommended by Chief Medical Officer; previous similar experience; should make good adjustment at this type of work; qualified for such work; training should increase subject's industrial competence and aid in post release adjustment.
