CONDITIONS "1 & 2" of PROBATION:

Condition 1—Within five days after actual institutional custody under this sentence has terminated, defendant will pay into the treasury, through the Clerk of this Court, unless he has already done so, the full amount of the several fines imposed in connection with Counts 1, 2 & 3.

Condition 2—Within five days after actual institutional custody under this sentence has terminated, the defendant will pay into the treasury, unless he has theretofore done so, full amount of the income taxes due from him to the U.S. and the full amount of civil penalties assessed against him, or such lesser amounts as the department of the treasury shall consent to accept in full settlement.
