Dear Friend:

In 1936 we were led to believe that Lloyd Stark was our friend, that he was for Old Age Pensions, but we have learned differently.

He now calls us "CHISELERS AND CHEATERS" just because we may have a brother, a son or daughter. He has stricken hundreds from the Rolls without a HEARING. This is not the law and the Governor knows it is not the law, but he is trying to get the courts to say it is the law.

While he drives around all over the state in luxury asking that you support him, he and his disciples at Jefferson City refuse to give you more than half what you are entitled to. In many instances, much less. He has the money to pay you but he never will unless you check his unjust and unfair policies, which are directly in violation of the law. The prospects for aged people to receive future assistance are doubtful. An official investigation should be made of his Social Security Board. A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE should be called to investigate Stark's activities immediately. To permit him to continue will jeopardize the rights of every aged person.

There will be a great mass meeting and rally for all of our aged people and their friends, Sunday, July 31st, 2:00 P. M., at the Municipal Auditorium, where the real facts will be given you. If you desire to remain on the pension roll, then by all means be present at this most important meeting. There will be appropriate music for the occasion. It is your duty to bring as many with you as you can.
