Educated in Public Schools and at United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland.

Served 8 years in U. S. Navy, resigning in 1912 to become General Manager of Stark Nurseries at Louisiana, Mo., established by his great grandfather 120 years ago and now the largest in the world.

Entered World War in June, 1917, as Captain of Field Artillery in U. S. Army. Advanced to the rank of Major and served with distinction in St. Mihiel and Meuse-Argonne battles in France.

Returned to private life at close of War and has since taken an active part in civic and business affairs.

Was General Chairman of campaign which resulted in passage of \$75,000,000 State Highway Bond issue in 1928 and sponsor of provision for Farm-to-Market roads.
