Dear Mr. Kenton:

I received your letters referring to work to be done in various counties, this morning, and note what you say regarding the Wright County factional fights. I am somewhat in touch with that condition and know most of the parties personally. I believe I can enlist both factions for Judge Truman, at least I will do my best and let you know the results. Also understand you want me to see that someone looks after a number of other counties, I

will be compelled to give my home county two or three more days.

I am contacting a large number each day and find a great many for Mr. Truman but I am giving them literature and enlisting active work, I think I know who can do the work in this county. I am posting Mr. Truman's picture all over the county personally as I drive from place to place. Some of our state boys drive from town to town leaving considerable quantities of pictures and cards with local people expecting them to go out and post them but I have failed to see where many have done so. I am giving you this information as I believe there will not be many posted unless we do it ourselves.

I will go into Wright County within the next three days.

There is another matter I would like to call to your attention Mr. Scot Wilson, with the Highway Department, was in our city Wednesday and reported that Mr. Truman would withdraw from the race shorty, of course, I told it was a D-- lie. I am just giving you this information so you can handle it in any manner you see fit.

I will continue this work with all the speed possible and will let you hear from me from time to time I feel that with a man like you directing us down here in the seventh district we should carry same for Judge Truman.
