Dear Mr Mitchell:--

My last letter to you I said I would send you what I had written regarding the "Machine tactics" in Jackson County government With your permission. You had previously requested this, and I probably should not have expected your further consent, however I was looking for a reply for the past two weeks.

What I have written, is the history of what I consider questionable transactions, and needs to be revised, and put in more attractive and appealing form, so that the voters will be swayed from machine rule.

I am going to send same to you tomorrow and register the letter, so that it may not be lost, as I have not a complete copy of what I am sending to you.

If you have time to read it over, rewrite anything you may see fit and add anything you may decide to make it stronger and more effective. there is much that may be shortened, as I may have gone to much into detail, in order to prove my contentions.

This can be shaped so as to be of value to any of the candidates for Senator from this state, outside of the Kansas City's machine candidate.

My wife is the only member of my family that is in favor of my taking any action against the machine, as there are two members of my family working in political jobs, and they say, that if I do anything of this nature, it will put them out of a job, which is true, but if what I have is written is of any value, I feel that they could be taken care of by those who may be benefited, and with that end in view I am sending you what I have written, and if you think it has no merit as political information, kindly return same to me and I will forget the matter, although I feel that with this information, the domineering and unlawful acts of the machine can be pictured to the out state voters in such a manner as to deprive the machine candidate of many votes.

When returning the papers, or writing me kindly address me at 1420 Wabash, Kansas City Mo. as I wish to keep any information regarding our transactions from the knowledge of my family for the present at least.
