Yours of April 22nd received.

In reply thereto, I beg to advise that I am in favor of the resubmission of the Eighteenth Amendment and the return of the control of the manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquors to the states.

I believe the cause of temperance would be furthered and the "bootlegger" as an institution largely destroyed, if the Volstead Act were so amended as to permit the sale of light wines and beer. Of course, if the control of liquor is returned to the states, the Volstead Act will pass out of existence.
