Dear Sir and Brothers:

You are familiar with the fact that the
Railroad Brotherhoods have endorsed the candidacy of Senator Harry S. Truman for
renomination and election. I have accepted an invitation to serve as a member of the
advisory board of the Truman Railroad Labor Committee which is active in this
Campaign.

At a meeting held last night with the officers of various railroad labor organisations in
Kansas City, which was also attended by Mr. David Berenstein, Director-General of
Senator Truman's Campaign, I learned that there was an urgent necessity that Railroad
Labor make an immediate effort to contribute financial support for this Campaign.

In October 1938 when an emergency board,
appointed by President Roosevelt, was holding hearings in connection with the request
of the Railroads for a 15% reduction in wages, Senator Truman appeared before that
board and testified that a wage reduction at that time could not be Justified. This
testimony on the part of Senator Truman was in part instrumental in a finding by that
board against a wage reduction, which kept dollars in the pockets of railroad employees.
We have the opportunity to reciprocate and contribute dollars to the Senator's Campaign

Fund.

Accordingly, I am enclosing one book of tickets to be sold at \$1.00. It is urgent that as many of these tickets as possible be sold and that returns be made not later than Tuesday, July 16. Please take hold of this matter and do your best to make a good return.
