### Conspiracy Trial Witnesses—

Government attorneys announced at the opening of the trial of a group of men and women on a conspiracy charge in Kansas City Dec. 31 that they expected to use Miss Nannie Belle Kennedy (left), Miss Hattie Bongers (center) of Hot Springs, Ark., and Miss Vera Felton (right) of Kansas City, telephone operators, to support their case. The government charged a plot was worked out over long distance wires to help Frank Nash, a federal prisoner, escape. Nash and four officers were killed in the Kansas City Plaza "Massacre" June 17, 1933.
