

AN ORDINANCE.

PROHIBITING ANY PERSON FROM ACTING AS A PROCURER PROCURESS, PIMP, OR FROM BEING AN INMATE OR MALE LODGER IN ANY BAWDY HOUSE, HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION OR ASSIGNATION, OR IN ANY WAY CONCERNED IN THE KEEPING OF SUCH A HOUSE, OR SOLICITING FOR IMMORAL PURPOSES UPON THE STREETS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1.—It shall be unlawful for any person to act as a procurer, procuress or pimp, or be a male or female inmate or lodger in any bawdy house, house of prostitution or assignation, or in any way concerned in the keeping, management or operation of such a house.

Section 2.—No persons shall solicit any person upon the streets of Kansas City for sexual intercourse or other immoral purposes.

Section 3.—Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment for a term of not less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months in the Municipal Farm of Kansas City, or the Women's Reformatory of Kansas City, according to the sex of the person so convicted; or by a fine of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$500.00; or by both fine and imprisonment.
